# More young people needed to complete housing survey

**Pulborough Parish Council is asking more residents to complete its survey to tell it how they see the village developing over the next 15 years.**

The initial response of the survey launched last month is more than 35 per cent, but councillors are encouraging more people to lodge their views.

Chairman Ray Quedsted said: "To receive back 787 returns is great news. The initial count shows that most were returned by the older generation but that was expected.

"However, it is a pity that most of the working age residents have not responded.

"Only 8.6 per cent of the 25-40 age group were moved to put pen to paper, despite a sizeable publicity campaign, and they are the ones who will, if they remain living in Pulborough, be affected most by any

changes."

They hope to get headline results ready for the Pulborough Harvest Fair on Saturday September 27 and detailed analysis will continue throughout the autumn. The evidence supplied will be used to show what the village wants for their community.

Mr Quedsted added: "Anyone who wants to build in Pulborough parish needs to talk to the parish council about their future plans.

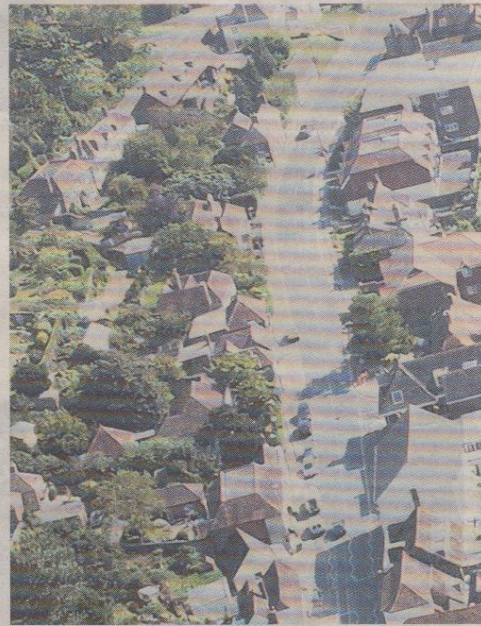
"If a potential site is not in the final plan then developers would have to be wary about the possibility of that site's future development.
