## YOUR PARISH COUNCIL

### Chairman's report

By the time that you receive this latest Community Bulletin, we will have in place a new Parish Clerk – Heather Knight – who has joined us, having previously been with Bognor Regis Town Council. This will be the first time that she has undertaken this particular role and I know that she has been looking forward to the challenge!

Lisa Underwood is remaining as Assistant Clerk, soon to be Deputy Clerk hopefully, so we will have a very strong team in place.

We have finally settled on the location, constitution and cost of our Trim Trail that will now be identified as Outside Gym Equipment. Financing through Section 106 contributions has been agreed with the District Council and installation on the recreation ground will take place shortly.

Our new Community Wardens have started and their presence will be felt throughout the whole Parish I'm sure.

The Neighbourhood Plan will be the subject of a re-appraisal by The Steering Group within the next few weeks. The Group representatives have been in lengthy discussions with the District Council to look at the site assessment process using a different model which will mean that the Plan will have to go to consultation once again but whether at Parish or District stage, is not certain at present.

We are currently re-evaluating the plans for improvements to the Sports Pavilion and hope to go out to consultation on our proposals before the year is out. **Ray Qusted, Chairman**

# Houses and homes in Pulborough

Many new houses have been built in Pulborough in the last few years and more will shortly be started and then soon finished. A house becomes a home, of course only when people move in and make it into a place where people care about the other people who share it with them. A village is a bit like a house: it becomes a living community when the residents there care about their neighbours.

Pulborough has a long tradition of being a caring community where people look out for each other. This year one charitable organisation is celebrating its 50th anniversary. Pulborough and District Community Care Association was co-founded by Jean Seagrim in 1966 and, like Jean herself, it is still going strong today. Initially, Community Care organised many different activities for all age groups in the village but in recent years has focussed more on people over the age of 50. The many activities range from a community

car scheme to Tai-chi and include a weekly lunch club and a social afternoon, to mention but a few. Volunteers, numbering over a hundred, say how rewarding and heartening their work is and find that it is an excellent way of getting involved in community life and feeling really at home in the village. The 50th anniversary will be celebrated in style in the autumn, when volunteers, will get together to celebrate this landmark in the life of Pulborough as a caring society. The photograph below shows Lower Street in the 1960s with a beautiful golden boot



hanging outside Knight's the boot makers and there is no afternoon traffic to be seen. Pulborough's population then was around 3,000 but now it is closer to 10,000. Much else has changed in the last 50 years: for example, women can now expect to live 8 years longer than they did then and men can now expect 7 more years of life compared with 1966. The golden boot has long gone but our Community Care Association continues to flourish. Why not join as a volunteer and help to ensure that lives continue to be enlivened here for another 50 years.
