

PUBLIC NOTICE

DEPARTMENT FOR TRANSPORT TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State gives notice of an Order made under Section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (South East) (No.48) Order 2018" authorising the stopping up of two part-widths of Stopham Road, comprising highway verge, at Pulborough in the District of Horsham. This is to enable development as permitted by Horsham District Council under reference DC/16/0728.

Any person aggrieved by or desiring to question the validity of or any provision within the Order, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement or regulation made has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks of 29 November 2018 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision included.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAYS (SOUTH EAST) (NO.48) ORDER 2018


The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of powers under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act").

1. The Secretary of State authorises the stopping up of the highways described in the Schedule to this Order and shown on the plan, in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by Horsham District Council under reference DC/16/0728.
2. The developer shall also, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Council, provide improvement of the highways at Stopham Road, as proposed and detailed in the approved planning permission, development plans and any associated legal agreements with the Council.
3. Where immediately before the date of this Order there is any apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across any highways authorised to be stopped up pursuant to this Order then, subject to section 261(4) of the Act, those undertakers shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus after those highways are stopped up as they had immediately beforehand.
4. In this Order -

"the developer" means Willowmead (Pulborough) Ltd

"the Council" means West Sussex County Council

"the plan" means the plan numbered NATTRAN/SE/S247/1979, marked "Highways at Pulborough in the District of Horsham", signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department for Transport, Deposit Document Service, F Floor, Ashdown House, St Leonards on Sea, Hastings, East Sussex, TN37 7GA.
5. This Order shall come into force on the date on which notice that it has been made is first published in accordance with section 252(10) of the Act, and may be cited as the Stopping Up of Highways (South East) (No.48) Order 2018.

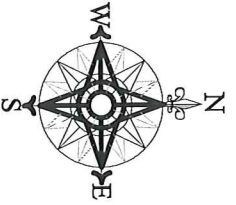
THE SCHEDULE

Description of highways to be stopped up

The highways to be stopped up are at Pulborough in the District of Horsham, shown on the plan as:

1. A northern part-width of Stopham Road comprising highway verge. Commencing 10 metres to the north of the north eastern boundary corner of number 7 Stopham Road, it extends in a westerly direction for a maximum distance of 60 metres and has a maximum width of 2.5 metres. (marked 1 on the plan).
2. A southern part-width of Stopham Road comprising highway verge. Commencing 18 metres to the west of the north western boundary corner of number 11 Stopham Road, it extends in a westerly direction for a maximum distance of 29 metres and has a maximum width of 2.5 metres. (marked 2 on the plan).
