E-CINS: Online confidential multi-agency sharing of caseloads.

Operation Crackdown: Joint initiative with Sussex Safer Roads Partnership and Sussex Police to report abandoned vehicles or anti-social driving.

DPA: Directed Patrol Activity (Sussex Police)

Section 59: Allows the police to give drivers a warning if they are reported to have used their vehicle in a manner which causes “alarm, distress or annoyance”. If reported to have done so again within a year the police have the right to confiscate the vehicle.

ASB/crime/criminal damage

- Ongoing neighbour dispute; advice given to residents to help collate evidence and how to report the issues.
- E-CINS cases opened and updated.
- Signposted resident to report cannabis use in neighbours garden.
- Advice given to resident regarding welfare concern for various issues in neighbours property.
- Engaged with adult resident regarding the dangers of having a small fire in woodland area.

- Spoke to young people about starting fires locally. Referrals made to FireWise project for education around fire safety.
- 2 x drug intelligence reports submitted to Police.

Parking/vehicles

- 2 x Section 59 warnings issued to motorcyclist for continued anti-social noise/nuisance.
- 1 x Section 59 warning issued to car driver for wheel spins in a public car park.
- 1 x Community Protection Notice for anti-social use of a motorcycle. Reported breach of Section 59.

Fly tipping/littering/graffiti

- 2 x fly tipping reported in Strawberry Field and Stopham Road.
- 1 x dripping overflow pipe at Strawberry Field reported to Housing Agency.
- Reported broken fence panel in Pocket Park to Parish Council.
- Overgrown hedges blocking pavement in Stane Street Close were reported to Saxon Weald Housing to cut back.
- HDC parking team informed of broken metal fence in car park at Lower Street.
- Littering found in woodland area's following lockdown gatherings.

Community engagement/events/meetings

- Engaged with young people attending SCYP with the Purple Bus during their summer activities on the recreation ground.
- Attended Multi-agency and team meetings virtually online.

Patrols (foot/visible and car)

- Mobile patrols of the whole parish during every shift targeting hot spot areas.
- Increased foot patrols to check open spaces i.e. recreation grounds and playground equipment and to engage with groups gathering.
- Visits to homes/businesses keeping within social distancing guidelines.

Elderly and youth

- Home visit to vulnerable resident which required calling an ambulance for emergency assistance.
- Urgent support for resident in need of food. Organised food parcel donation and signposted them to receive befriending calls and ongoing support.

- Encouraged residents relying on the Volunteer Hub service to regain independence and confidence to return to local food shops for essentials.
- Support and advice given to relative of a vulnerable male living with mental health condition.
- Referred elderly female resident to the Proactive Care Team for help with mobility aids and Age UK for further support.
- Assisted vulnerable male resident to resolve dispute relating to fishing club rules and regulations.
- Signposted resident to Community transport.

Licensing

- Nothing to report.

Dog related issues

- Reports received of a boisterous dog that was not kept under control and was a concern for other users on the recreation ground. Resolved by speaking to both parties resulting in no further action needing to be taken.

Cycling

- Nothing to report.

Parish specific/other

- Participated in a meeting with Coastal West Sussex regarding the promotion of Pulborough as a tourist destination for water sports enthusiasts.
- Engaged with local business regarding reports that PPE guidelines were not being adhered to.
- Joint outreach youth work has been set up with SCYP throughout the summer holidays.
- Arranged joint patrols with Fire Service aimed at young people to raise awareness about the dangers of starting fires in woodland areas.
