## Elderly and Youth

We've had five calls regarding concerns for older residents in the village. Two we've been unable to identify and two are already receiving support. The other is a resident that we've signposted for various support to include Appetito, volunteer visiting, occupational therapy amongst others. We've also supported an older vulnerable couple that is living in very poor conditions and signposted to adult social care, housing and environmental health.

We have referred two young people into the Early Intervention Programme which is designed to offer support as they are coming to our attention. Both families on board.

We also supported a very vulnerable resident with mental health and have signposted to relevant services.
