ASB crime/criminal damage

- Information discussed with the Police relating to concerns made to us and on social media platforms about an egg throwing incident at Adversane being a scam that targets drivers to stop in a layby.
- Fly tipping report submitted supported with evidence of the offence.

 2. Vehicle details of driver without license.
 3. Covid-19 breach.

Parking/vehicles

- 2 x Operation Crackdown reports submitted:
 1. No MOT
 2. Driving with tipper base still up.
- Parking continues to be monitored/evidence gathered following the issue of Community Protection Warning to Dominos franchise, Lower Street.

Fly tipping/littering/graffiti

- Fly tipping reports submitted x 4
 1. Lower Street, Car Park - 2 x office chairs.
 2. The Street, Nutbourne - Overhead electrical cabling on grass verge. Liaised with UK Power Networks.
 3. Hill Farm Lane – general household rubbish.
- Abandoned shopping trolleys reported to Trolleywise (x3).
- Street lights reported as not working on route from Church Place to Train Station (x2).
- Reported an unsafe fallen kerb at Rectory Close.
- Reported bonfire concern on land at North Heath to Environmental Health Team.
- Reported large pothole on A29 London Road.
- Reported human waste discarded on roadside along Stopham Road.

Community engagement/events/meetings

- Meetings attended continue to be held virtually:
 1. HASBRAC conference call.

 3. Multi-agency meeting (Vulnerable adults)
 4. Core family meeting.

Patrols (foot/visible and car)

- Mobile patrols of the whole parish during every shift targeting ASB hot spot areas and Covid-19 breaches.
- Foot patrols to check open spaces i.e. recreation grounds/playground equipment
- Patrols increased to woodland areas in response to reports of campfires.

Elderly and youth

- We continue to make welfare calls to our vulnerable older residents as identified from requesting support during the first lockdown and our community link alarm customers that live within the Parish, signposting to support agencies when required.
- Signposted resident to the Police and adult social regarding concerns for vulnerable male.
- Advice and reassurance given to vulnerable adult with Covid-19 anxiety and school closure.
- Advice given and resident signposted for home security system following incidents at the property.
- Discussion with family support worker around support strategies for young person to help manage risks in the community.
- Safeguarding referral submitted for vulnerable older person needing support.
- Referral x 2 to NHS social prescriber for local support/intervention.
- 2 x young people referred to the Early Intervention Project, multi-agency approach to help families access support and to manage ASB and risky behaviour of the young person.
- Support and advice given following a mental health crisis of family member.
- Engaged with SCYP (youth services) information sharing relating to young people of concern/ASB.
