E-CINS: Online confidential multi-agency sharing of caseloads.

Operation Crackdown: Joint initiative with Sussex Safer Roads Partnership and Sussex Police to report abandoned vehicles or anti-social driving.

SCYP: Sussex Clubs for Young People.

ASB: Anti-social behaviour.

OP APOLLO: Sussex Police COVID-19 response.

DPA: Directed Patrol Activity (Sussex Police)

Section 59: Allows the police to give drivers a warning if they are reported to have used their vehicle in a manner which causes “alarm, distress or annoyance”. If reported to have done so again within a year the police have the right to confiscate the vehicle.

ASB crime/criminal damage

- Resident reported concern about groups starting fires on the Brooks during dry hot weather.
- 2 x children’s bikes stolen from outside home address. Police informed.
- Evidence of fire and large quantity of litter found at Park Mound Gun Emplacement.
- Groups of young people gathering on privately owned land. Engaged with young people involved and suggested other activities and places to meet up.

Parking/vehicles

- Report received of anti-social use of motorbike visiting Rectory Close area.
- Complaint regarding a vehicle parked dangerously and causing an obstruction at Swan Corner Corn Store by the river access. Spoke to vehicle owner and it was moved on request.
- Complaint regarding a vehicle parked and not moved in a layby for over 7 months. Signposted to Operation Crackdown.
- Vehicle parked for 2 weeks in a space that obstructed the Hearse stopping for funeral services. No parking restrictions in place; a polite notice was left for consideration of Church services and disabled access.

Fly tipping/littering/graffiti

- Fly tipping reported x 2
 1. Gay Street Lane
 2. Lower Street, Car park
- Fly posting x 16 removed from street furniture
 1. Property For Sale sign
 2. Keep fit Company
- Reported alleged burning of plastic on a bonfire to Public Health.
- Graffiti and Litter (including drug litter) found at Park Mound Gun Emplacement. Litter pick completed and arranging removal of graffiti.

Community engagement/events/meetings

- Engaged with SCYP summer activities on the recreation ground throughout August.
- Engaged with new owners of the White Hart Public House to introduce the warden scheme.

Patrols (foot/visible and car)

- Mobile patrols of the whole parish during every shift targeting hot spot areas.
- Increased foot patrols to check open spaces i.e. recreation grounds/playground equipment and to engage with groups gathering.
- Visits to homes/businesses keeping within social distancing guidelines.

Elderly and youth

- While our clubs and social groups remain closed, we are keeping in touch with our vulnerable elderly/families via telephone/email to offer reassurance and to help with any queries that may arise during this time.
