Project Outcomes Refer to these outcomes in your report below. Did we achieve these?	Due to Covid –19 all sessions were offered using the Purple Bus. To engage with as many young people as possible, offering a wide range of activities, help and advice, during these unprecedented times. To engage with the local community including parents and parish councilors. Activities offered included sports (Rounders, Football, Cricket). Tile painting, T-Shirt design, board games, Arts & Crafts.
Session Highlights / what went well Attach pictures at the end of the report	T-Shirt design and painting were received very well, every young person that attended a session throughout the summer took part in this. Some of our younger attendees took part in Tile painting and showed how talented they are. Learning to play chess was started early in the summer and culminated in a mini tournament between 4 young people, the progress they made was remarkable. We had groups of young people who played football, cricket, and rounders. Choosing teams was something that they found particularly difficult in the beginning, however after a few weeks they were happy to have both good and poor players on their teams. This showed that they were all learning it was about having fun and not winning. There was one session that was attended by a young person who suffers with Autism, his father said he was worried as the young man struggled to concentrate and mix with others, the young person stayed for 45mins and completed a t-shirt, and took part in a cricket game.

We had an issue with some young people who were visiting relatives in the area and came to the bus, they were disruptive, used bad language and tried to steal items of equipment. This was reported to the community warden and names of young people were already known to them.
