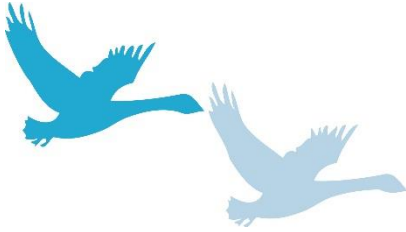

**Recommendations of the Planning & Services Committee meeting held on
Thursday, 19th September 2019**

DC/19/1803 - 31 Glebelands Pulborough

Erection of a two storey side extension, single storey rear ground floor and first floor extensions, installation of a balcony over existing garage and single storey front extension with balcony over.

No objection: However, the Council has concerns regarding the potential for over-development in the area

S106/19/0015 – Land North of Highfield, Stane St, Codmore Hill

Variation of the form of nomination agreement under reference DC/15/1084 to incorporate cascade provisions to allow nominations to persons outside the Horsham district once all nominations have been exhausted with local connections to Pulborough and within the Horsham District.

No objection: However, the Council is concerned that people outside the Pulborough area may have the opportunity to occupy Pulborough homes.
