ASB/crime/criminal damage

- Complaint received relating to noise nuisance on the recreation ground. Groups spoken to about consideration of neighbouring properties and being on playground equipment whilst closed during Covid-19.
- Reports of cannabis affecting quality of life to neighbouring properties. Police /Housing informed.
- Reports received of egg throwing into gardens at Chestnut Walk and New Place Road.
- Intelligence shared with Tesco security guard regarding theft of alcohol.

Parking/vehicles

- Daily noise nuisance reported about anti-social use of motorbikes affecting several locations in the Parish.
- Reports submitted to Operation Crackdown and Police re: anti-social driving/noise of motorbikes.
- Reports of Mopeds on the recreation ground – reports submitted.
- Parking issue in Stane Street Close involving three parties. No restrictions in place, advice given to help resolve the matter and to improve communication between those involved.
- Arrangements made with businesses at the Train Station industrial estate to help alleviate the parking issues at Swan Corner relating to customers of water sports clubs.
- Reported two untaxed vehicles to DVLA.

Fly tipping/littering/graffiti

- Enquired with environmental agency regarding fly tipping on the River Arun Pulborough Brooks area – items to include a bike and oven.
- Fly tipping reported at the car park in Lower Street. Rubbish found by charity bins; reported and items have now been cleared.
- Overflowing bin reported in Barnhouse Lane.
- An adopt-a-street kit has been given to a new volunteer recruited to help clear up Stane Street.

Community engagement/events/meetings

- There have been no community engagements/events due to Covid-19 restrictions. Meetings have continued online.

Patrols (foot/visible and car)

- Mobile patrols of the whole parish during every shift targeting hot spot areas.
- Foot patrols are limited to checking open spaces i.e. recreation grounds and playground equipment.

Elderly and youth

- 3 x child safeguarding reports submitted.
- 1 x adult safeguarding reports submitted.
- 2 x calls to Police re: concerns for welfare.
- Continue to oversee the Hub volunteers and action any referrals that arise from it.
- Via the volunteer Hub we arranged weekly befriending call to resident feeling isolated and lonely.
