We are currently running this as a Purple Bus session, due to Covid-19 we no longer have access to the youth Centre at the school. This has given us some challenges to overcome, however the sessions are now benefitting from an increase in numbers.

We ensure that each week we provide arts & crafts which we base on a particular theme each week, the Young People are happy to take part and there are only 2 Males who refuse to engage in this activity, they prefer to do a sports activity. So, whilst we are running arts and crafts, they are usually nearby kicking a football or playing cricket.

We have faced some challenges in the sessions, due to different groups of males falling out with each other outside of the Youth Club setting. They have all been happy to explain their side of events and worked alongside the youth workers, to help to try and put their differences aside, especially whilst attending club.

Sports activities are a firm favourite with all young people that attend, football seems to be a winner each week, this has also helped in breaking down barriers between groups.

One of the advantages of being outside is we have made new contacts, which are attending each week.

We have also managed to engage on a regular basis with a male who is known to the local community wardens, this has been a pleasing outcome as he now regularly attends and engages well with youth workers and other members.
