Chairman's report

The Neighbourhood Plan has moved on slowly as a result of a recent meeting with Horsham District Council at Billingshurst. This meeting was attended by a number of other parishes just starting out on their own plans.

Due to delays which have taken place, we will be contacting all site owners who offered sites for development some 2 years ago to see if there are any changes of which we need to be aware. We shall also be publishing requests for any further sites which may have become available since.

The Council are moving ahead with plans to develop or renew the Sports Pavilion and it has been agreed to seek tenders from Project Managers within the coming weeks.

Work has started with volunteers to improve Pocket Park and volunteers are already working to maintain our recently designed Memorial Garden. Should anyone feel that they can devote time to either of these projects our Parish Clerk would be pleased to hear from you.

Some road improvements have taken place at Swan Corner and others are planned along Lower Street in the near

The new car parking charges have been met with a lot of criticism and the Council will be monitoring the situation carefully over the coming weeks.

Our Neighbourhood Wardens still continue to do sterling work in the village.

Shortly will we need to provide a considered response to Horsham District Council's consultation regarding Gypsy and Traveller Sites.

Next month will be the Annual Parish Meeting that I hope that many of you will be able to attend.

Neighbourhood **Wardens report April 2017**

We are now firmly embedded within the community and the scheme is gathering momentum, we continue to help residents with support and advice. Recent projects include working with Tesco in a clear up of Pulborough Pocket Park to make it a nicer and safer place to visit and play, this will be on-going. We have also been instrumental in resolving dog fouling problems near to Sainsburys and have more recently instigated a joint working policy with Victim Support to further help people who become victims of fraud. Residents have voiced that they feel reassured to have a visible patrolling presence.

St Mary's CofE (Aided) Primary School

Colour returned to the school grounds as the daffodils emerged! The Spring Term came to an end and what a wonderful term it has been. Our choir went to the O2 Arena in London and sang at the Young Voices concert. Our children joined 7,000 other children to participate in an evening concert and many of the parents came to hear their children sing at this sell-out event. It was a truly memorable evening for all who took part.

World Book Day produced an array of costumes showing the children's favourite books adorned the playground and classrooms and the children listened to stories read by different teachers. The older children buddied up with the younger children for reading sessions and a sponsored bookmark and book character competition attracted almost 200 entries.. Medals and prizes were awarded, well done to the winners! Some of our Year 6 children also finished The Weald Book Award. This involved reading six books in a short space of time and sharing this experience with other pupils from the locality. They attended the celebration evening at The Weald School and presented the winning award to author Jane Elson who wrote 'How to Fly with Broken Wings'. This award has really raised the profile of the value of reading within the school.

The younger children made pancakes to celebrate 'Shrove Tuesday'; a range of toppings were available and photographs can be seen on our website. Father Jack conducted our Ash Wednesday service at school and the term finished with the Year 3 and 4 children performing the Easter Play, 'Amazing Love'; excerpts of this were also performed during our Easter Eucharist

in church. A truly memorable end to the term. An article of our Easter celebrations appeared in a double-page spread in the local paper (see photo below).



We also had a record number of entries in this year's Pulborough Garden Society Spring Flower Show. Children from St Mary's entered a wide range of categories; the most popular being creating Vegetable Monsters, Edible Necklaces and pictures or collages of Animals. There were just too many winners to mention but really well done to you all. Taking part in the Flower Show is a great way of getting involved with village life.

Now the Summer Term is underway and we are delighted to say that the swimming pool is up and running. Special thanks to our PTA and everyone else who helped with the fund raising projects to replace the swimming pool boilers.

We are excited about our new themes for the children's learning; these include Mr. McGregor's Garden, Journeys, Mayans, Temples, Tombs and Treasures, Go with the Flow and Our Wonderful World. In addition to this the Year 6 pupils are getting ready for their tests and then their residential trip to the Isle of Wight with PGL. Many of the other classes have got also trips planned, as well as Forest Schools and other outside learning opportunities.

We look forward to several new children who have recently moved into the village joining us in the Summer Term. We are also starting to think about next year and the special welcome we will be giving to our new Reception children. As part of our healthy eating curriculum the children have been planting vegetables in our garden. We will then be able to eat our own produce during snack time later in the year.
