Surgery to 3x Cherry (Works to Trees in a Conservation Area)

PPC Comments: Objection

Following advice from the Woodland Trust, the best time to prune cherry trees is in late summer or early autumn when the sap is still circulating and not rising, pruning at this time of year will be harmful to the tree's.

The application does not appear to confirm a qualified tree surgeon has been consulted, this work should not go ahead unless completed by a qualified tree surgeon.
