

## To vote for or against the Pulborough Neighbourhood Plan

#### Reading the Plan

#### Can I Vote?

You must be registered to vote in a local government election and your qualifying address must be in Pulborough Parish. Postal votes will be used but you must register with Horsham District Council for a postal vote. Polling cards will sent to everyone registered.

You will need picture ID to vote in person.

# HOW TO VOTE

### Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> September

At Pulborough Sports & Social Club, Rectory Lane, RH20 2AJ

7am - 10pm

You are asked to vote 'yes' or 'no' to this question

"Do you want Horsham District Council and South Downs National Park Authority to use the neighbourhood plan for Pulborough Parish to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?"

You vote by putting a cross (X) in the 'Yes' or 'No' box on your ballot paper. If more people vote 'yes' than 'no' in this referendum, then Horsham District Council and SDNPA will use the Neighbourhood Plan to help it decide planning applications in Pulborough Parish.

If more people vote 'no' than 'yes', then planning applications will be decided without using the Neighbourhood Plan as part of the Development Plan for the local area.
