E-CINS: Online confidential multi-agency sharing of caseloads.

Operation Crackdown: Joint initiative with Sussex Safer Roads Partnership and Sussex Police to report abandoned vehicles or anti-social driving.

SCYP: Sussex Clubs for Young People.

ASB: Anti-social behaviour.

HASBRAC: Horsham Hate Crime and ASB Risk Assessment Conference.

DPA: Directed Patrol Activity (Sussex Police)

Section 59: Allows the police to give drivers a warning if they are reported to have used their vehicle in a manner which causes “alarm, distress or annoyance”. If reported to have done so again within a year the police have the right to confiscate the vehicle.

ASB/crime/criminal damage

- Received several reports relating to noisy motorbikes around the village, at anti-social hours and regularly visiting the same locations causing a nuisance to nearby residents.
- 2 x E-scooter – words of advice given for:
 - riding on pavement
 - on recreation ground

- Supported and signposted resident with neighbour nuisance complaint relating to noise.
- Reports of recycle/waste bins being knocked over at different locations around the village.
- Referred Pulborough area to be raised at HASBRAC meetings - to identify, risk assess ASB and target relevant resources/problem solve to help find solutions.
- Working with the Parish Council to help support a resident reporting incident of ASB on Cousins Way, recreation ground.
- Ongoing neighbour dispute – both parties visited, advice given, information shared with tenants housing authority.
- Signposted resident to report incident of suspicious behaviour outside their property at 2am hours to the police.
- Signposted residents to report ASB noise nuisance from motorcycle use to the Police.

Parking/vehicles

- 3 x untaxed vehicles in Arun Prospect reported to DVLA.
- Joint patrols with parking services at St. Marys School drop off/collection times.
- 5 x Operation Crackdown reports:
 1. For close pass of a horse.
 2. For using a mobile phone whilst driving.
 3. For driving on pavement.
 4. For parking on pedestrian white zig zag lines (x2).

Fly tipping/littering/graffiti

- 1 x large pothole reported
- 1 x flooded path reported
- Dealt with precarious fallen tree situation on the recreation ground.
- Reported an overgrown emergency access path to Saxon Weald.
- Liaised with HDC's cleansing team regarding some fly tipping that was removed by a farmer in Stream Lane.

Community engagement/events/meetings

- Visit to the Men's Shed project in Shipley with Pulborough Committee.
- Attended Caring Café at the URC and engaged with residents.
- Attended SCYP's youth activities during half term week.
- Worked with Pulborough Community Partnership with planning future village events.
- Attended Farmers Market for our 'Meet & Greet' session and share information with attendees.
- Meeting with the new Family Support Worker in our area.

Patrols (foot/visible and car)

- Mobile patrols of the whole parish during every shift targeting hot spot areas.
- Increased foot patrols to check open spaces i.e. recreation grounds/playground equipment and to engage with groups gathering.
- Visits to homes/businesses keeping within social distancing guidelines.
- Joint patrols with PCSO's.
- Joint school parking patrols to promote new safer parking posters and signs.

Elderly and youth

- Referral made to Adult Social Care for resident with mobility issues at home.
- Visit to elderly resident to assist with concerns relating to an overgrown pathway and emergency access route.
- Signposted a resident to Wednesday Club for social interaction.
- Assisted vulnerable resident following removal of flowers and items at grave site.
- Reassurance and advice given to a resident concerned by a telephone scam call.
- Advice and support given to vulnerable older person – victim of verbal abuse and intimidating behaviour. Police aware.
- Welfare concern raised with appropriate agencies to assist resident.
- 1 x safeguarding referral for vulnerable young person.
- Signposted resident to report to the Police an incident relating to their child.
- Liaised with The Weald School and Brinsbury College to share concerns relating to students.
