**29. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

Apologies were received from Mr L Adsett (Bowling Club), Mr T Reilly (PFC), Cllrs. Bignell & Qusted.

**30. MINUTES**

The Minutes of the Meeting held on 14th February 2019 were received, agreed and signed as an accurate record.

**31. REPRESENTATIVES' REPORTS AND ITEMS**

Allotments

Shed no 1's roof needs repair and the sheds in the newer plots need their repairs completed. The Deputy Clerk will liaise with the Groundsman.

Cricket Club

Hopefully outdoor nets will be played at the end of the month, weather depending, and the first league match is due on 27.04.19.

Mr Woolgar requested an update regarding the pavilion rebuild. Cllr. Clarke advised the following:

- Studio 5 are due to submit a new set of drawings for part refurbishment and part new build.
- The Parish Council is liaising with Horsham District Council's Head of Sports & Culture regarding possible funding.
- A business plan will be prepared, ready for any funding applications.

Mr Woolgar also advised that the Cricket Club have support from the Sussex Cricket Board to help recruit juniors from the local primary school.

Snooker Club

Mr Walsh asked the Committee Members if the snooker club could get another key cut (to be kept in the key box) for their non-S&SC members for toilet access to the changing room toilets. Members **AGREED** to this. Mr Walsh will also arrange for the toilet to be cleaned as needed.

Mr Walsh also asked about what their lease stated about access to the snooker room as some non-S&SC snooker members may not be able to access the snooker room via the S&SC. The Deputy Clerk will check and report back.

The Deputy Clerk asked if snooker club members could turn down the radiators in the snooker club when leaving the building, although it was noted that 2 of the thermostats were broken. Mr Walsh advised that the snooker room needs to be kept to a certain temperature at different times of the year because of the snooker tables, but Members will limit the temperature accordingly and he will arrange for the 2 broken thermostats to be repaired.
