**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON

25. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Mr L Adsett (Bowling Club), Mr T Reilly (PFC), Cllrs. Caplin & Court.

26. MINUTES

The Minutes of the Meeting held on 10th January 2019 were received, agreed and signed as an accurate record.

27. REPRESENTATIVES' REPORTS AND ITEMS

Allotments

Mr Nunns advised that plot holders are waiting for the frost to go and then planting can start. There are two shed roofs which need repair, the Deputy Clerk advised that the Groundsman will get the materials to do this.

Cricket Club

No match reports but the club are producing flyers to recruit more juniors and are working with St Mary's to offer after school cricket activities. The new chain link fence has now been installed.

Snooker Club

Mr Walsh asked if the Snooker Club could get 35 keys cut for its members to access the internal door to the snooker room via the Sports & Social Club (S&SC) as the S&SC will no longer hold the key behind the bar. The Deputy Clerk suggested that the Snooker Club install a key box and give the code to its members, rather than having that many keys cut. Members of the R&OS Committee agreed to this and the Snooker Club will arrange accordingly.

PFC

Mr C Jupp advised that it has been too wet for any matches. He reported that the locks do not work on the two big changing rooms (thought to be 3&4), the Deputy Clerk will arrange for these to be looked at.

After each representative report, Cllr. Quested requested updated information from each club to be used with progressing the Sports Pavilion rebuild project.
