



# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Temporary closure of Stopham Road, Pulborough, 28th June 2021

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Stopham Road, Pulborough, in the Horsham District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Stopham Road either side of the rial bridge

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 28th June 2021 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 1st July 2021) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Connect on behalf of Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd undertakes a Night Road Closure for concrete repairs . Closure points - junction with Church Hill and Junction with Bedham Lane

The restriction will be in place **overnight only** from 22:00 until 05:00

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
