The Parish Council is very aware of the issues and problems caused by the A29 road closure following the landslip in late December, and the impact this is having for both Pulborough residents and residents in nearby villages. The Parish Council and Councillors are in close contact and working with West Sussex County Council and Horsham District Council to identify the local problems and seek solutions or mitigation for them. The physical causes behind the landslip and possible remedies are complex and may take some time to become clear. Engineers have been commissioned and we understand that the County Council anticipates completing works by 31st January 2023. In the meantime, the County Council is reviewing diversion routes and signage. Our Pulborough Neighbourhood Wardens are proactively addressing issues arising from the A29 outage especially relating to access to St Marys School. As new information emerges, we will post updates on our website and Facebook page.

In the interim, until the A29 is reopened, we appreciate traffic will be extremely heavy during school pick up and drop off times, combined with rush hour traffic. We ask that you do not use New Place Road, Glebelands or Rectory Lane to take or collect children to or from school to help alleviate gridlock in these areas. If you are coming from the south, please consider using Lower St car park by the library (parking conditions apply) and walk up Potts Lane, or if coming from the north then please find alternative suitable parking and walk along New Place Road.
