

PULBOROUGH PARISH WARDENS' REPORT July 2019

Projects

- We've worked with a resident to help set up swimming sessions at St Marys school for the summer holidays for the residents
- We've got the bicycle mobile pump track coming to Carpenters Meadow for a week in the summer holidays with funding provided by the PCC (Police and Crime Commissioner)
- Day of Action arranged for Carpenters Meadow early August for a clean-up and engagement exercise to show joint working with partner agencies to revitalise the area responding to residents' concerns. Thu 8th August. All Councillors welcome to join in.

Environmental

- 1 x fly tipping at Swan Corner river slipway not yet removed
- 1 x flytipping reported on Stopham Road
- 1 x dangerous street light reported at Stane Street Close

Older/Vulnerable

- Vulnerable resident assisted with scam. Action Fraud and Police reports made on behalf of them.
- Ad hoc scam chat with lunch club members addressing recent concerns.
- Engagement with VOP re social isolation. Signposted to lunch club and other village events.
- Welfare check to VOP following hospital stay.
- Visit to VOP following attempt break in.
- Assisted VOP with wasp's nest and bank payments.

Young People

- 4 x free sports sessions arranged for August on the rec to include Shoretrax (bike track), dodgeball and football.
- Currently working with 5 x families with children jointly with the ASB team. This includes concerns around CSE and CCE (Child Sexual Exploitation and Child Criminal Exploitation)
- Young person put onto ABC (Acceptable Behaviour Contract) following reports of dangerous cycling

Referrals/Signposting

- Signposted VOP to Appetito as struggling with cooking home meals.
- Referral made into EIP (Early Intervention Project) for young person who is coming to our attention.
- Drugs intelligence passed to Police x 2 regarding drugs use in particular roads within the parish.
- 2 x safeguarding referrals for young people.
- Reported the traveller trailer in Gay Street Lane to County Council

- Referred resident to West Chiltington parish council re abandoned caravan on their land.
- OP Crackdown report made re motorbike being ridden dangerously in the parish.
- Missing young person in parish. Found and returned home and relevant agencies advised. Support continuing with family involved.
- Intelligence submitted to Police re a fire in the Glebe Field as persons named. Will be referred to a Firebreak course in due course.
- Community Link referral made for resident

Engagement

- Attended a full Community Safety Team meeting at Parkside to share information and learn what is new within Community Safety.
- Letter drop made to residents in Cousins Way and Orchard Way on behalf of parish.
- Attended fun fair before opening to speak with staff there to outline our expectations of them whilst they are there.
- Asked businesses to help out with watering of plants in Lower St in Fred's absence.
